## Pegasus Water Polo Academy Athlete Code of Conduct

Athletes are expected and agree to:

- Be on time prepared with all necessary gear and equipment
- Commit to attend all team practices and games; when unable to attend, communicate with a coach in advance
- Wear suits appropriately and as designed
- Encourage, support, and communicate appropriately with teammates
- Strive to be an exceptional leader lead by example, be encouraging, always give full effort
- Address concerns about self, teammates, coaches or team culture directly with a coach in a respectful manner

The following behaviors will not be tolerated:

- Bullying or harassment of any kind, whether of teammates, opponents, peers, or any person, including inappropriate use of technology and/or social media
- Use of offensive, abusive, or inappropriate language in the presence or directed at anyone connected with the Pegasus program or activity
- Verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any coach, parent, athlete participant, official or any other person
- Disrespectful or argumentative behavior with coaches and/or referees

Should any athlete violate this Athlete Code of Conduct, act inconsistent with it, or bring discredit or discord to Pegasus Water Polo Academy or USA Water Polo, the athlete could be subject to disciplinary action by the Pegasus Coach and/or Board of Directors, including termination of the athlete's membership in Pegasus.
