Another Successful Year Ends

The Pegasus water polo team ended the 2021 year by competing in two tournaments, The Thunder Mini Tournament and the Cowtown Stampede, and then held a fun holiday scrimmage with parents and coaches against the youth.

Thunder Mini Tournament held Dec 4-5, 2021 held locally. Scores were not officially counted at this tournament.

Cowtown Stampede Tournament held Dec 11-12, 2021 locally: Pegasus 10U mixed, 12U blue, 18U girls and 18U boys went 4-0 to win their divisions. 12U Pegasus red placed 6th, 14U red placed 2nd, and 16U boys placed 4th.

Dare to Dream Tournament held Jan 15-16, 2022: Our 10U and 12U athletes traveled to Houston to compete in the annual USAWP Dare to Dream Tournament that is more of a fun travel tournament for the younger athletes. The 10U team was the only undefeated 4-0 team again. 12U blue went 2-2 with big wins over Longhorn and Viper Pigeon. 12U red consisted of mostly first time

tournament athletes, played hard, and learned much in their 0-4 record. Pegasus took 26 athletes to this tournament which is an amazing turnout!

Olympic Development Program (ODP) Summary



The ODP West Regional Championships were held in Salt Lake City on Jan 8-9. The Southwest, Mountain, Pacific NW and Hawaii Zones all participated in the Development, Cadet and Youth age groups. While the Regional Championships were festival-style rather than a typical tournament with an overall winner, the Southwest Zone did well overall, and we had three teams who won all four of their games: Development Girls SWZ Stars, Cadet Girls SWZ Stars, Youth Boys and SWZ Stars. Following Regionals, Pegasus had 28 athletes selected to go to the ODP Nationals Championships.

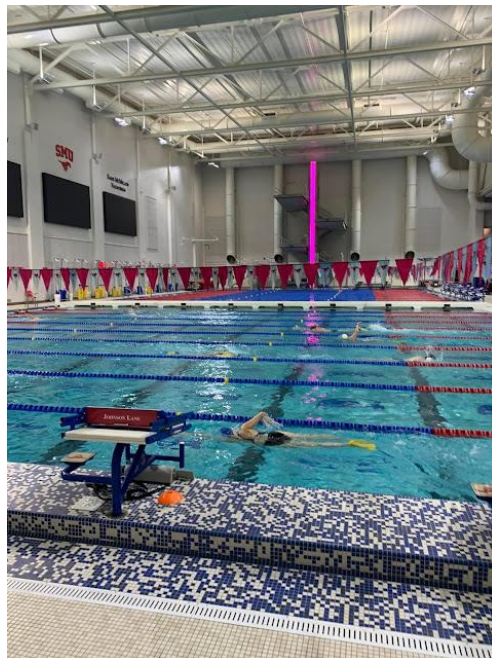
The Pegasus Dallas Masters Water Polo team will be traveling to Austin UT Swim Center on February 12-13 for the Spin Lob Classic Tournament.
